SIMONE FISHBURN, PH.D.; EXECUTIVE EDITOR, BIOCENTURY AND BIOCENTURY INNOVATIONS

Simone serves as Executive Editor of *BioCentury* and *BioCentury Innovations*. She was previously Editor of *BioCentury Innovations*, and prior to that was a senior editor for *SciBX: Science-Business eXchange*, a joint publication between BioCentury and Nature Publishing Group.
